We will print the picture in the show program and read the bio during the Rescue Horse at Halter class. If your rescue is an USERL equine, just send the bio and we will provide the "before" picture, if applicable.*

Directions: From Hwy 220 North in Greensboro take exit for Hwy 158 East towards Reidsville and go for 5.6 miles. Flintrock Farm will be on your left. Watch for the signs!

1. \$8 per class.
2. Formal attire optional. Boots are required.
3. The judge's decision is final. It should be accepted in the spirit of true sportsmanship. Under no circumstances will any person be allowed to discuss complaints with the judge. Complaints can be reported only to Horse Show officials.
4. Well-behaved dogs on leashes are permitted on the horse show grounds.
5. All entries under age 18 must have a parent, guardian or trainer sign each entry form and wear a helmet.

6. Riders must wear protective headgear passing testing standards whenever jumping anywhere on the show grounds. Helmets may be worn in Western Classes instead of Western Hat.
7. Standard horse show rules will be the basis for judgment and all points not covered in the general information section.
8. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on show grounds.
9. USERL or Flintrock Farm assume no liability in case of theft, loss or damage to persons, horses, ponies or personal property from any cause, and upon this condition only are entries accepted.
10. The show committee reserves the right to combine or cancel classes.
11. Schedule subject to change pending weather.
12. Parking is free, but donations are appreciated.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CLASSES

1. **English Equine at Halter** – No other tack, horse will be judged on conformation and handling.
2. **Open Rescue Equine at Halter** – Does not have to be a USERL rescued equine. Share your story with us—one paragraph on a 3” x 5” index card to be turned in with your entry form.
3. **Lead Line** – Age 8 and under – riders will be lead in arena by a handler.
4. **Walk Only** – May have handler but may not enter in any other riding classes.
5. **Pairs** – Two riders will be riding W/T/J holding toilet paper between them. Last team to break or drop their ribbon wins. They will be placed 1st thru 5th.
6. **Open Rescue Equine Walk/Trot/Jog** Does not have to be USERL rescued equine, will be a judged class.
7. **English Walk/Trot (No Pattern)** 1st – 5th 12 & under
8. **English Walk/Trot (No Pattern)** 1st – 5th 13 & over
9. **English Walk/Trot/Canter** – 1st – 5th places.
10. **Hunter Hack** – Flat work including walk, trot, and canter, then to navigate two jumps.
11. **English Equitation** - 1st – 5th places.
12. **English Go As You Please**- May rack, trot, or walk your horse. **No Cantering.**

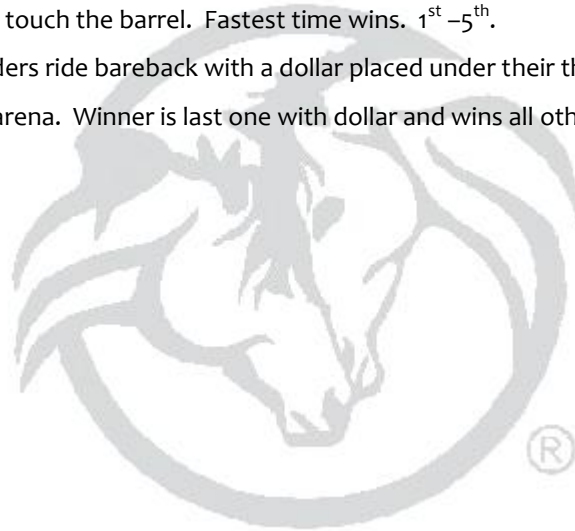
13. **Costume Class** –17 & Under - Lead or ride your horse in Costume – walk only. 1st –5th
14. **Costume Class** – 18 & Above - Lead or ride your horse in Costume – walk only. 1st –5th
15. **Western Equine at Halter** – No other tack, horse will be judged on conformation and handling
16. **Showmanship** -- 1st – 5th.
17. **Bareback Equitation** – Walk/Trot/Canter sans saddle
18. **Western – Walk/Jog** – 1st – 5th. 12 & under.
19. **Western – Walk/Jog** 1st – 5th. 13 & over
20. **Western Pleasure** – Walk/Jog/Lope 1st – 5th Places.
21. **Western Go As you Please** - May rack, jog, or walk your horse. **No loping, or running.**
22. **Open Game Horse Go As you please.** Non-traditional show horse, gaming horse, walk/jog, no loping or running

Break for ring crew (set up trail class)

23. **Trail Class** – 17 & under - go over poles, check the mailbox, take raincoat and put it back, walk over tarp, go to cones and back your horse, walk to gate. Three refusals and move on to the next item.
24. **Trail Class** – 18 & over - go over poles, check the mailbox, take raincoat and put it back, walk over tarp, go to cones and back your horse, walk to gate. Three refusals and move on to the next item.

Break for ring crew to tear down

25. **Egg & Spoon** – Rider will be furnished with egg & spoon. Horses must travel at the announced gait. Anytime egg is dropped you must go to the center. No thumbs holding or gum permitted. 1st – 5th At least 3 entries.
26. **Drink Race** – One rider at a time, a cup of water/drink will be placed on a barrel. Rider must ride to barrel on one side, drink entire amount, and race back from opposite side of barrel to start line. Fastest time wins. 1st–5th
27. **Phone Book Race** - Rider will be told a page number, you run your horse down to the barrel, get off horse find the numbered page, rip numbered page out of phone book, making sure you don't come back on the same side of the barrel and race back to finish line. Timed Event. 1st -5th
28. **Flag Race** - Riders begins on either side of the arena, and grabs the flag from bucket, riding around the arena and then placing the flag in the bucket on the other side, and then on to the finish line. Your flag must stay in the bucket or you are disqualified and will receive no time. Timed Event. 1st -5th
29. **Barrel Race** – Race around barrels in proper barrel pattern. (See poster.) Any barrel knocked over will result in a 5 second penalty added to time. Rider may touch the barrel. Fastest time wins. 1st–5th.
30. **Ride-a-buck** (winner takes all) - Riders ride bareback with a dollar placed under their thigh. No touching. If dollar falls out you must go to the center of the arena. Winner is last one with dollar and wins all other dollars.
